All devices our emails are accessed on have anti-virus software and are password protected. This means we are protecting your data as much as possible at every step of its usage. Information we may collect and process the following data about you: Information you give us. You may give us information about you by filling in forms on our site www.virtualrunningevents.co.uk, placing an order or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail, social media, in person or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you submit evidence, subscribe to our mailing lists, use contact forms, create an account and when you report a problem with our site. This also includes the information given to process your order(s). The information you give us may include your name, address, e-mail address and phone number, financial and credit card information, personal description and details.

Information we collect about you. With regard to each of your visits to our website we may automatically collect the following information: · technical information, including the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the Internet, browser type and version, time zone setting, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform; information about your visit, including the full Uniform Resource Locators (URL) clickstream to, through and from our site (including date and time); pages you viewed or searched for; page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), and methods used to browse away from the page. Information we receive from other sources. We may receive information about you if you use any of the other websites we operate or the other services we provide. [In this case we will have informed you when we collected that data that it may be shared internally and combined with data collected on this site. We are also working closely with third parties (including PayPal, Google Analytics, Heart Internet Analytics, search information providers and may receive information about you from them. When signing up to a mailing list, we ask for your name and email address. We do this so we can see that we are talking to the correct person.

Submitting evidence through the website - We will ask you for your name, order number and email address when using the evidence submission form. We ask for this in order to tie the evidence and order together to process posting the medal(s). We may use your details to contact you should it be necessary (for example not enough mileage given). When a medal is posted, your order will be updated to reflect this and an email will be sent from our system to notify you of the message.

Entering Competitions on social media.

When entering competitions on our social media platforms, we use your name to enter into a random line drawer using random.org. For any winners, we will then reply to your comment and ask you to message our page to receive your entry code. It is then your responsibility to purchase your entry on the website and use the discount code within the dates given to you. All Terms and Conditions are then agreed to by purchasing the entry. We store a screenshot of the draw results with names but no details to prove the draw was fair.

Providing Social Media Posts.

We do not post any photographs without full consent of the photograph owner. If you have given us consent to use your photograph, we will use it on our social media platforms (and website if applicable) but we will only use a first name (where applicable) and no surname or contact details to insure privacy to our customers.

COOKIES.

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website.

This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. We only use Google Analytics & Heart Internet Analytics for this purpose.

USES MADE OF THE INFORMATION We use information held about you in the following ways: \cdot Information you give to us. What information we keep on paper – proof of postage if postage has been bought online. This includes your name and address.

WordPress - www.virtualrunningevents.co.uk is built and updated and maintained in the WordPress platform. The website is password protected. When placing an order, your customer information will be stored within the website files and only be used to process and update you on the status of your order. How we dispose of sensitive information. All information that is not of a sensitive nature is recycled. For anything containing sensitive data, we shred & burn all paper so it cannot be traced.

DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may share your personal information with any member of our group, which means our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries, as defined in section 1159 of the UK Companies Act 2006.
